MEMBERSHIP

Membership to the Top-3 Organization will be available to, and limited to, any and all E-7 selectees, E-7 through E-9's assigned to Tinker Air Force Base, Oklahoma, regardless of branch of service, Major Command, or unit. Members of allied services, holding equivalent grade, are also eligible for membership.

Active membership is voluntary and granted upon application. Full membership entitles the member to hold office if elected, vote in all matters, participate in all activities and have a say in the business of the Top-3 Organization.

Associate memberships are available to retirees working or living in the local area, who have retired in the grade of E-7 through E-9. Associate membership is granted applicants upon approval of the general membership. Associate members have a non-voting status and are unable to hold elected office.

A member may terminate membership at any time, by notifying, in writing, any member of the Executive Committee.
